### 1. Accreditation by Teachers Council of Thailand

The curriculum was accredited and certified by the Teachers Council office at meeting no. 6/2023 on June 29, 2023, under certification code 3920 (International Program). ### 2. Application schedule, selection, and announcement of results

- 2.1. Application for admission till 08 May 2024.
- 2.2. Applicants will receive notification of the interview schedule via email.
- 2.3. Notification of interview outcomes will be disseminated through email.
- 2.4. Confirm your entitlement to enroll in our program by payment of the first semester fee.
- 2.5. The orientation session and official registration will be conducted through the online system on 01 June 2024.
- 2.6. Classes commence on 08 June 2024.

## 3. Applicants working as teachers in schools, please submit the following documents in the form of photographs or scanned files:

- 3.1. Certificate and Transcript of Records of Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree (if any) in any academic discipline from an accredited institution.
- 3.2. For non-native English speakers, certificates of English Language Proficiency Test results (TOEIC, TOEFL, IELTS, etc.)
- 3.3. Passport photo, sized 1" or 2", taken in full-face view, directly facing the camera without hat and sunglasses.
- 3.4. Application Fee (non-refundable) Baht 4,000.
- 3.5. Passport (bio page and the latest visa stamp).
- 3.6. Valid Work Permit first page and the latest permit stamp page.
- 3.7. Temporary Teaching Permit or License issued by the Teacher's Council of Thailand (Khurusapha).
- 3.8. Current School Employment Contract in a K-12 School.

## 4. All other general applicants, kindly submit documents numbers 3.1, 3.2, 3.3, 3.4, and 3.5 mentioned in the above list.

### 5. Program duration and Class schedule

The program spans 1.5 years, divided into 3 terms. Classes will be held exclusively on weekends, either on Saturdays or Sundays, from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

### 3. Guidelines for Teaching Profession Internship courses 146 202 and 146 203

- 3.1 Arrange work as a school teacher in an educational institution that teaches basic education, including childhood, primary, secondary, or in a higher secondary school.
- 3.2 Must perform duties as a teacher teaching in an educational institution according to item 1 for not less than 6 hours per week and/or other administrative work not less than 10 hours per week.
- 3.3 Educational institutions that allows teachers to Intern should have a supervisor who holds a teaching license.
