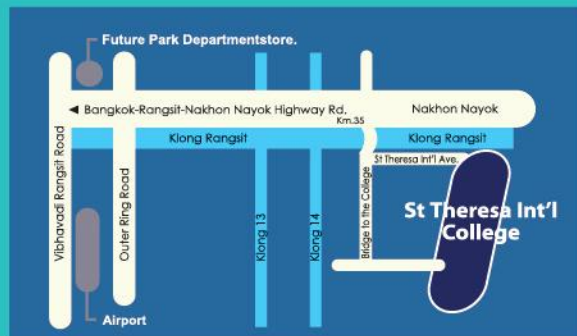
Admission Requirements
